A Strategic Shuttle Service Initiative at MWC



Team MWC

ahindra World City (MWC) took a step forward to improve customers' last-mile connectivity by starting a shuttle service programme. Following discussions held in various forums and surveys carried out by MWC, this initiative will seek to tackle transportation problems affecting park users. It will also facilitate a smooth connection between central points inside and outside MWC.

Routes and timings:

The Shuttle service will operate on two specified routes, designed to serve the most commonly used commuter paths within MWC:

- Route 1: Paranur Station to 8th Avenue
- Buses: 32-seater & 22-seater
- Route 2: Zero Point to 8th Avenue
- Buses: 32-seater & 22-seater

Operational hours:

- Morning: 7:00 AM 11:00 AM
- Evening: 4:00 PM 8:00 PM
- Service days: Monday to Friday (excluding weekends)

The shuttle services will be a pilot for three months with a fleet of four buses on two busy routes. This trial phase will enable MWC to evaluate the viability of the service, facilitating services within the park to be expanded depending on the feedback obtained.


During this period, MWC will assess the service's effectiveness and gather feedback from commuters. Based on the outcome of this pilot, the shuttle service will become a permanent feature for our clients.

Important points to remember:

To ensure the smooth operation of the shuttle service, we request all commuters to take note of the following guidelines:

- The shuttle buses will only stop at specified locations. Please refer to the attached map for 'stop' details.
- Seating will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Once seats are full, passengers must wait for the next bus.
- A valid Company ID card is mandatory for boarding the shuttle. For contract employees, the ID card must include the company logo and specify their 'Contract' status.
